Nurse-guided companionship for connected aging — weekly calls, local visits, caregiver reassurance, and referral guidance when another level of care is needed.

For local partners: pharmacies, social workers, retirement residences, community programs, faith groups, and wellness providers.

For diaspora and community partners: organizations abroad whose members want warm, non-clinical check-ins for aging loved ones in Canada or internationally by phone/video.

Who to refer

Good fit	Families concerned about loneliness, low routine, distance caregiving, or a loved one who would benefit from a consistent weekly conversation or visit.
Typical need	Non-clinical companionship, mood check-ins, gentle activity prompts, caregiver updates, and a trusted relationship that does not feel institutional.
Not the right fit	Bathing, toileting, transfers, medication administration, urgent safety risks, or PSW/home-care needs. We can still help point families toward an appropriate provider.

How to refer a family

1. Share the family name, city/country, preferred contact method, and why the referral may help.
2. Ubuntu Legacy Care Circles replies within 24 hours to arrange a 10–15 minute consult.
3. The family receives a recommended package, start date options, and clear expectations before the first call or visit.
